Brantwood Farms is very excited to be offering farm tours for the 2024 fall season! With over 30 years of experience in agriculture education, these tours have been crafted by our team to give students of all ages a taste of the magic that happens on the farm during our favourite time of the year.

## YOUR DAY AT BRANTWOOD FARMS

Your class can expect a day filled with outdoor fun, farming and friends. Our farm tours include the following activities

**Apple Picking-** Each student will have the opportunity to pick 5 apples to bring home

**Pumpkin Picking -** Each student will explore the pumpkin patch and pick a pie pumpkin of their own. Student will also be picking a cob of popcorn to share with their families

**Farm Animals-** Meet and greet our friendly goats, pigs, chickens and rabbits

**Wagon Ride-** Enjoy a tractor pulled wagon ride around the farm with a stop at the Magic Forest to learn about trees and our woodland friends.

**Corn Maze-** Explore the giant field of corn and meet some favourite characters from movies, tv and books

**Play-** Depending on time, and the wishes of teachers/class supervisors groups may try out the giant jumping pillow, super slide, cereal box & obstacle course. *If you wish to avoid or skip any of these activities please speak to your tour guide.*

## FAQs

**When: YOUR TOUR IS TWO HOURS** from start to finish. Please time your arrival and departure accordingly

Tours are available for morning or afternoon sessions.

Mornings can start at either 9:30 or 10am

Afternoons can start at either 12:00 or 12:30

**Where:** The farm address is 251 Powerline Road, Brantford.

**How Much:** Tours are \$13.50+hst per student. One adult supervisor (school staff or volunteer ) is free per 5 students\*

Additional parents or volunteers are \$13.50+hst

\*EAs or Staff for students requiring 1:1 support do not count towards the ratio and are always free

**What to Bring:** Each student is asked to bring 1 or 2 durable reusable bags to take home apples, pumpkins and popcorn. We are **NOT** able to provide plastic bags to take items home. Water-bottles, hats, and sunscreen are encouraged.

### **Additional Information**

Tours run rain or shine and are outdoors. Please ensure students are prepared the proper clothing and footwear for the conditions.

Stops for snack breaks are not included in the tour program. If you would like to stop for a snack break please let us know at the time of booking. Please note - **LITTERLESS SNACKS ONLY**- any trash created will to be taken home.

### **Payment**
